

When Jesus gathered with His disciples that last night (before His betrayal) for a meal, they were sitting down to the Passover meal. If you have ever participated in a Seder, you know that a cup of wine is raised at key intervals in the meal. There are the Pastors Desk traditionally four cups representing the promise of God in Exodus 6:6-7 "Because I have heard your groaning, I will bring you out, I will deliver you from slavery, I will redeem you and I will take you to be My people". These four realities are celebrated at Passover. Freedom from their hard labor, slavery, splitting Red Sea, and becoming a nation. (Exodus 19:6) "you will become My treasured possession, a Kingdom of priests, a Holy Nation"). There is also a fifth promise and a fifth cup, "and I will bring you back to Canaan, the promised land, the land of your forefathers." This is the Elijah Cup, but it is not drunk, it is symbolically poured in anticipation of the coming of the Messiah. Does this ring any bells for you? Jesus has heard our cry, He has delivered us from the hard labor of trying to please Him with our own efforts, with the servitude to our enemy to which we had been in bondage, He has redeemed us by removing the wall and barrier between us and himself (parting the Red Sea), He has made us a treasured possession, a royal priesthood and a holy nation. And He promises to lead us in the great Marriage Feast of the Lamb when He returns.

Hello to All,

It has been amazing how the Lord has so ordered things in our lives so as to give us a tiny glimpse of what the refugees have to endure... and this without the horrors of war, forced flight and suffering that they have experienced. Simple love and faithful friendship goes a long way here.

What an incredible opportunity to be here in Germany on the 500-year anniversary of Martin Luther's jumpstart of the Reformation! It is profound that God would bring these refugees here to Europe to experience His love and truth. We sow and water...but the growth is so beautifully from Him.

We are adjusting continually to the movement/transfer of refugees which is initiated by the government here. We trust the Lord will use this scattering to increase our options for influence. We have already seen this occur since our key refugee home was suddenly cleared of families in December...who were subsequently scattered over a 25 kilometer radius.

- we are gradually getting our new apartment into livable shape
- Sam and Ian are still enjoying school and their German is coming along well
- we are now below \$1,500 per month for needed support
- ahhh! the 'red tape' paperwork monster is still alive and well
