

Our church's first VBS was an overwhelming success and we can't thank you enough for your prayers. Laura Kate and a gifted team of volunteers put on a fantastic program that was gospel-focused and allowed us to connect with many new families.

Update on the McKays

We have had an eventful December which began on the first weekend at a missions event with World Outreach, the missions branch of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church (with which I am ordained). During that weekend, Sandra and I agreed to pursue the application process with them as a covering for our call to the Black Forest and Beyond! It should serve to expedite the support process and I have been a

Teaching Elder with them for over 20 years, so there are few surprises...on that front. One of the great and unexpected highlights was going into a number of Muslim-owned businesses and singing Christmas carols pending their permission, which was usually granted. The responses were amazing and warm and an encouragement to us as we walk this path toward ministry among refugees in Europe. Germany just passed the one million mark for refugees this year alone!

We were also privileged to minister again in Memphis, with Sandra sharing at a women's luncheon and a chance for me to teach a few times on "Glory Moves In." We continue the path that we believe the Lord has for us to Europe and are thankful to all of you for your love, support and prayers.

Year End Update from the Roes

We're in the US until July 2016 which is coming quick!

Even before the European refugee crisis was "in the news" Courtney had an opportunity to travel to Sicily and help our mission dream about how it might engage refugees in Europe. Just a few months later our mission



has mobilized an incredible response that you can read about here: <u>www.GEMission.org/Refuge</u>. Here in the US we led our church in collecting 423 pairs of shoes for the refugees in Europe.
