

#### Haywood Christian Academy Senior Campus Minutes of Congregational Meeting December 3rd, 2017 @ 12:03 pm

**Present:** Rev. Edward Brouwer, active ruling elders, inactive ruling elders, deacons and members of the congregation. A quorum was declared.

**Call to Order/Opening Prayer** – Edward Brouwer called the meeting to order at 12:03 pm and gave the opening prayer.

#### Purpose & Business

The purpose of this meeting was to hear the report of the Nominating Committee, vote on the nominating committee candidates for 2018, review the proposed 2018 budget, and vote on the terms of call for the minister for 2018.

1) **Nominating Committee Report –** As chairman of the committee, Bruce Kingshill reported that two(2) candidates for ruling elder and two (2) candidates for deacon were recommended by the committee. The nominees and terms of service were:

Sam Mitchell - 3 years	Will Roberts – 2 years
Sarah Altman– 3 years	Art Altman - 3 years

Bruce Kingshill asked for additional nominations from the floor. There being none offered, a motion was made by Phil Inglis to close nominations from the floor. After a second by Glenda White, the motion passed unanimously. A motion to approve the slate by acclamation was made by Phil Inglis, seconded Sam Mitchell and approved.

2) Nominating Committee for 2018– Bruce Kingshill presented the following members to serve on the Nominating Committee for 2018: Bill Allsbrook, Alan Bush, and Paula Rhodarmer. Bruce Kingshill asked for additional nominations from the floor. With none being offered, Sam Mitchell moved the nominations be closed, Glenda White seconded and the motion passed. Phil Inglis made a motion that this slate of members for the Nominating Committee for 2018 be approved. After a second from Renee Mitchell, the motion passed unanimously.

3) **Review of Proposed Budget for 2018 –** Treasurer Bruce Kingshill reviewed each major item on the budget. The Elders tried to keep the budget and expected giving equal. Giving was flat so the budget remained flat.

a) Missions Budget – The total budget remained the same as last year.

b) Staff was given a 2% increase with reductions made in other budget line items reflecting 2017's use of funds.

c) Total of the 2018 budget is \$204,434

4) **Review of the Terms of Call for the Minister –** Bruce Kingshill served as moderator pro temp while Pastor Brouwer was excused for this discussion. He reviewed the terms of call for the Minister and explained that a 2% increase was proposed by the session.

Glenda White made a motion that the terms of call for the minister be approved as presented. After a second by Phil Inglis, the motion passed unanimously.

A motion to adjourn the Congregational Meeting was made by Wally Cook, seconded by Phil Inglis and passed unanimously.

The meeting was closed in prayer by Rev. Edward Brouwer at 12:17 pm

#### Haywood Christian Academy Senior Campus Minutes of Corporation Meeting December 3rd, 2017 @ 12:17 pm

## **McKays December Update**

Like you, we're amazed that this year is already drawing to a close. The snow has already begun and we know that this winter season can be a challenge to gain access to some of the refugees here. We had the privilege this past weekend of helping the Syrian couple mentioned in the previous newsletter to move into their new apartment. They are so grateful for the help, since there is a lot of paperwork and bureaucracy to wade through here (as everywhere). Sandra's work is not yet done in that process. We are likely to gain access to more Syrians in the same housing through this process! We will take Sandra's mother to eat with them tomorrow.

As 2017 winds down we look to the Lord for His doors to open. There are still many refugees, particularly from Afghanistan and Iraq that face the possibility of being sent back to very dangerous situations due to the current political climate here. One of our Iraqi friends is still waiting for papers to stay in Germany after two years... the wait has turned him from a nominal M. back to his daily M. prayers, much to the surprise of his wife. Please pray that we will have the opportunity to share the Truest Love with them. The brother of one of our Syrian friends here has remained in Syria in order to keep his pharmacy going. He is now facing the prospect of baving to pay constant bribes to the government in order to keep from being

having to pay constant bribes to the government in order to keep from being closed down. It is by no means a peaceful situation.

We are very grateful for your love and support through this past year and for the time to come. Please consider Engaging the Displaced among refugees in Germany in your year-end giving. His peace will prevail, the McKays
