"A thief in the night" is the term that Paul writes to the church at Thessalonica to let them know that the coming of the Lord will be unexpected,



at an hour you don't anticipate. (Jesus used the term in Matthew's Gospel and John in turn in Revelations). There was so much persecution at that time, so many strange things going on, plus a general understanding of the apostles that the Lord's Second Coming, His return, was imminent. So much so that some people had quit their jobs because, after all, why do anything if Jesus is coming today or tomorrow? Paul tells them to wait in expectant hope but that in the meantime, since none can know the time of Christ's return, we are all to work with our hands and continue to give a good and beautiful witness to unbelievers. In the fall of 1979, a local Pentecostal church in my hometown of Red Deer Alberta had a series of revival meetings that showed the 1972 film "A Thief in The Night". I was on my way home from a late study night at the local High School (9th grade), walked by the church and saw the parking lot full and the shimmering light of a film being watched--so I stole up into the balcony and watched the rest of the movie. Now mind you I had been raised in a lovely Christian home and knew Jesus to be my Saviour from my earliest memories, but being the strict hardworking Calvinists that we were, there was little talk of Jesus' return and more talk of how can we make the world a better

place through our life and calling? Be that as it may, this was the first time I had heard an "altar call" and right there in the back of that church, I made an adult decision to give my life to Jesus. That was 43 years ago, an entire generation. The coming of Jesus is closer today than ever before but He will not come according to our well-worked out maps and diagrams. Don't spend an ounce of your energy on figuring out the end times scenarios. Rather give all your creative energy to living for Jesus, sharing the gospel, and bearing fruit for His Kingdom. And whether we pass before He comes or whether we meet Him in the air, let us strive to the upward calling in Christ. Even so, Lord Jesus, Come Quickly.
