The Gospel of Mark records a conversation between a young man, well connected, wealthy in worldly terms, longing to understand what he should do to inherit the kingdom of God. He approaches Jesus, already a famous teacher and rabbi though himself a young man in his early 30's. This rich young ruler,



having grown up as a good Jewish boy, starts the exchange with due respect addressing Jesus, even with eagerness since he runs toward him, kneeling, and says "Good Rabbi, what must I do to inherit eternal life?" Jesus' response is curious and at first confusing: "Why do you call me good, there is no one who is good except God." In essence, Jesus is driving at this young man's motivations for coming to him in the first place. Jesus is not rebuking this man nor is Jesus saying that he is not "one with the Father." Jesus is laving the groundwork to help him understand that eternal life is not determined by obeying a set of rules, but rather by entering into a relationship with the One Who invites us into life abundant, both now and forever. Jesus is not saying that Law is unimportant, by all means, he assumes this young man knows that following God's law is the beginning point of eternal life. Jesus cites 6 of the 10 And the response? "Rabbi I have Commandments. observed all these from my youth." Jesus affirms his response but additionally, the gospel records that he loved him. Jesus truly sees this young man and is moved in His spirit with deep agape. And Jesus knows that despite all outward religious appearances, love of wealth (the money trap) was this man's idol. antidote, the cure, the test of this: "Go and sell all you have give it to the poor and come follow me!" Tim Keller, in his commentary on Mark draws our attention to the idea that Jesus himself was the ultimate Rich Young Ruler. He left glory, wealth, and love in the incarnation. As Paul writes; "He became poor so that we might become rich." Keller goes on to write "Does it move vou to think what Jesus did for you? When that begins to really move you, amaze you, make you weep, you'll have a fighting chance of avoiding the (money) trap. Letting Jesus' sacrifice melt you will drain money of its importance to you. You can give money away or you can keep it, depending on what's best at the time." Hmm Pastor Edward
