**THURSDAY** 6:45am - Men's Prayer Group Law versus Grace. This is a theme one sees running throughout the history of the Bible and also Church History. It's what Luther

discerned in his epiphany of God's grace rather than achieving status with God through performance. It's what God told Adam and Eve after they had sinned so grievously--that He would send a Savior who would crush the head of the serpent--our ancient enemy. It is what God so



powerfully affirmed in the life of Abraham, who believed the promise of God and stepped out in faith and obedience. And it's what the author of Hebrews is so earnestly writing about to Messianic Jewish believers. He says something pretty radical in the 8th chapter saying that the old covenant was flawed! Well. it was fine in so far that it was a shadow, a sign, a pointer to something so much better and greater. Actually, he writes that the Law itself wasn't defective, it was people who were defective! To put it another way, the Law and the Old Covenant that it represented was like a recipe. In every detail a perfect indicator, written down as it was, but representing the potential and possibility of a full and satisfying indeed lifesustaining reality. But we all know that a recipe is not a meal. Directions to a place or goal are not actual arrival. In fact, with the coming of Jesus, he writes that the old way of thinking has become obsolete. In other words, we don't need a recipe pointing us to the reality anymore, we simply can come to the Savior by faith and "taste and see that He is good". In the incarnation, Christ has taken the righteousness of the law, fulfilled it in and through His own obedience, even to death, and now singularly and for all time and to the uttermost. because of His indestructible life, applied it to us! He has taken written words, on tablets of stones, and by His grace and the gospel, written these on hearts of human flesh. The old has passed behold the new has come. Pastor Edward

# God Uses a Gift and a Letter to Change Lives

As a 7-year-old in Mongolia, Jargalmaa (pictured left) described one particular day as "unexpected." After school, her teacher invited her to a church where she received her very first gift! This Operation Christmas Child shoebox gift included, among other fun toys, stationery, and a set of hairclips. Inside, she also found a letter that said, "You are valuable and so loved by God." Jargalmaa cherished this message because her parents and grandparents had never told her that they loved her.

Jargalmaa went on to participate in The Greatest Journey discipleship program where she especially appreciated the lessons about God as Creator. Later in 10th grade, she accepted Jesus as her Lord and Savior. Through her testimony, five of her family members and two close friends also made this life-changing decision.

Now 15 years after receiving her shoebox gift, Jargalmaa, her husband, and two young children (pictured above) have recently moved to a new community where they are ministering to youth in hopes of starting a church.

"I would like to challenge people who are preparing shoebox gifts to also write a letter showing God's love," Jargalmaa said. "What's written there may be very simple, but those simple words could completely change somebody's life."

## New Curriculum and New Sunday School classes for our children in Grades 1-7!

Starting on November 5, we will have two Sunday school classes for our children: Class 1: Grades 1-4 Class 2: Grades 5-7

Our new curriculum comes from Great Commission Publications whose mission fits very well with ours:

"We help churches carry out Christ's Great Commission to "Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you." Matthew 28:19–20

... we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ. Ephesians 4:15 (ESV)"

### A little about each level:

*For Grades 1-4*, the first quarter is titled "Worshiping God": "In this interactive Sunday school curriculum, your learners will discover important biblical truths as they look up, figure out, do, respond and listen. The teacher becomes a facilitator and instructor, enabling students to actively find out Bible truths on their own, learningBible study skills as they read from the Scriptures. The Holy Spirit works in their hearts and minds as they discover what God's Word says."

*For grades 5-7* the two-year study is G2R (Genesis to Revelation Bible Survey): with the aim being, "to point students to the Scriptures, ask questions, and fill in the gaps, not lecture. Students will learn much as they dig into God's Word for themselves, as well as from the discussion of others in the group. This interactive methodology will challenge the new learner as well as the more well-versed student...The intent of G2R Bible Survey is to whet the appetites of your preteens and young teens to desire God's Word and to grow closer in relationship with Christ as they see God's whole story from beginning to end. In all of this we pray that our children will grow as Jesus did: "in wisdom and in stature and in favor with God and man." Luke 2:52
