One of my all-time favorite Bible verses is from the book I am now preaching through. Hebrews 4:12 states "for the Word of

God is living and active, sharper than a two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and spirit, of joints and marrow and discerning the thoughts and the intentions of the heart." It resonates so deeply with me because the Bible in its 66 books, in the Old



and New Testaments, written over 1500 years by dozens of authors in several different languages, has One, True and Singular Author: namely the Spirit of God. And when the God of All speaks, His Word is alive and transformative, cutting to the quick like a surgeon's scalpel, countering our rationalizations and doubts, pointing us to the truth of the gospel that God is always pursuing us. stripping us of our defenses against Him and graciously offering us salvation through His great rescue plan in Jesus. In the context of the book of Hebrews and this particular section, the writer tells us that God's Spirit speaks now, in the moment, and expects us to respond "today". He speaks comfort and healing as well as admonition. The upshot of the letter to the Hebrews is: do not postpone obedience when God speaks to you. The beauty of God's Word, in narrative, poetry, gospel, epistle, and history, is that the Spirit quickens the Scripture to point to His truth in our lives. So we listen or study or meditate upon God's Word asking the Spirit to reveal His truth to us. We could spend a lifetime reading and contemplating the Bible and never run out of applications for our own lives. Let us be hearers and doers of God's Word.

Global Missions:

The Team arranged two interviews with missionaries: Rev Grady Davidson with Timothy Two and Annaliese Smith with WO Mongolia (ELIC). We approved a one-time gift of \$500 for each. We also approved a one-time gift for *Voice of the Martyrs* and plan a Moment for Mission in October. We also approved \$500 for Engage2025 Indonesia through our presbytery. These funds will come from our Yardsale \$. Renee presented an opportunity with Compassion International "Hope Starts Here". We like the idea in principle and Renee will get more details.
